

## THE WAINHOUSE TOWER (AREA 3)

At a height of 253 feet, with 369 steps to its viewing gallery, the Wainhouse Tower is possibly Halifax's most prominent landmark. Built by John Edward Wainhouse, the tower was completed in 1875. It has been owned by Calderdale Council since 1974 and was renovated between 2008 and 2010.
